### ANGUS MACDONELL NAMED DIRECTOR OF HUNTLEY BOOKSTORE AT CLAREMONT UNIVERSITY CONSORTIUM

**CLAREMONT, Calif.** — John Beckman, Chief Administrative Officer for Claremont University Consortium (CUC) announced today that, after consultation with CUC, the Follett Corporation has named **Angus MacDonell as Director of the Huntley Bookstore**. Mr. MacDonell assumed the position of Director on January 29, 2009, replacing Jim Dwyer, who has served as the bookstore director during the past two years. Mr. Dwyer will assume management of the bookstore at the University of Georgia in Athens, Georgia. Both Huntley and the UG bookstore are owned and operated by the Follett Corporation.

I also look forward to working with the Claremont business community to encourage Huntley Bookstore as “the” local bookstore of choice for our community.”
