**DENISE HAYES NAMED DIRECTOR OF  
STUDENT HEALTH AND COUNSELING SERVICES FOR  
CLAREMONT UNIVERSITY CONSORTIUM**

**CLAREMONT, Calif.** — The appointment of Denise Hayes, Ph.D.,H.S.P.P., as **Director of Student Health and Counseling Services for Claremont University Consortium (CUC)** was announced today by Robert A. Walton, Chief Executive Officer for CUC. Dr. Hayes assumes the position July 13, 2009.

As Director of Student Health and Counseling Services, Dr. Hayes will provide leadership for the three services that comprise Student Health and Counseling Services for The Claremont Colleges that include Health Education Outreach, the Monsour Counseling and Psychological Services, and Student Health. These services support the 6,300 students attending the five undergraduate and two graduate institutions that comprise The Claremont Colleges.

Dr. Hayes has been Director of Counseling and Health Services at DePauw University, a private liberal arts college of 2,300 students, since 1999. In this position, Dr. Hayes provides leadership for counseling and medical services, a service that has merged in recent years into a newly renovated Wellness Center. In addition, Dr. Hayes also holds the title of Associate Dean of Students and serves as a member of the President's Senior Administrative team. Prior to her position with DePauw, Dr. Hayes served as a Staff Psychologist, Coordinator for Consultation and Outreach, and Coordinator of Psychology Practicum for the Counseling and Psychological Services at Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana. In addition, Dr. Hayes has taught courses at Indiana University Purdue University at Indianapolis, IU Bloomington, Indiana State University and Kentucky State University. Dr. Hayes has published in the *Journal of College Student Psychotherapy*, the *Journal of Counseling and Development*, and she is a frequent presenter at professional conferences on topics related to student mental health. Dr. Hayes is President-Elect for the Association of University and College Counseling Center Directors (AUCCCD).

Dr. Hayes received her Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from Indiana University, Bloomington, a M.A. in Organizational Communication from IU Bloomington, and a B.A. in Speech, Theater, Communications from IU Indianapolis.

Robert Walton, Chief Executive Officer for CUC, in announcing Dr. Hayes' appointment stated, "Denise brings an excellent blend of experience working with undergraduate and graduate students in highly selective institutions. She understands the needs of college students living in a residential

community such as ours at The Claremont Colleges. She also brings the level of administrative skill and experience to take the next step in integrating the student wellness concept for CUC and The Claremont Colleges.”
